Sulphur Springs Public Library Policy for Unattended Children

Unattended Children

Children should be supervised at all times while at the library. Children ages seven and older may use the library unattended, subject to other policies and procedures adopted by the Sulphur Springs Public Library concerning behavior, conduct, and demeanor.

Disruptive children will not be allowed to interfere with library services to others. Disruptive behavior is any behavior on the library premises which infringes on the rights of others while using the library. Anyone displaying disruptive behavior will be asked to leave.

Unattended children left at the library will be placed in police custody, if a parent has not/ or parents have not arrived by fifteen minutes after the official close of the library.
