The SSPL Teen Summer Reading Club is for boys and girls ages 12 through 19. During June 7 through June 28 checkout materials from your local library, then fill out a registration form (See [www.sslibrary.org/Teens&Kids/TeenSummer Reading Club Registration form](http://www.sslibrary.org/Teens&Kids/TeenSummerReadingClubRegistrationForm)). To register for the club teens must either have their own library card or use a parent's/guardian's card to participant. Complete the process by reading (7) seven Sulphur Springs Public Library books or e-books located in the Tex-Share Libraries databases, fill out an entry for each book and submit in person at the library no later than 5p.m. Thursday, June 30. Remember to include your name, phone contact, school and grade.

Bring your completed sheets into the library to win a special prize that can be picked up at the library on Friday, July 15. All game sheets received after 5 p.m. on June 30 will be ineligible for rewards and the final drawing for a grand prize.
